### Apologizing

“I didn’t do anything! It’s not my fault.”

“He made me do it.”

“I didn’t do it.”

“She did it first.”

What do you hear when your child makes a mistake and is caught or blamed? How do you teach your child that it is okay to admit to a mistake, apologize, and receive forgiveness?

Our sinful world paints a picture around making a mistake that is full of hurt, revenge, only sorry if they are caught attitude, and a lack of love, mercy, and grace. It is a very selfish approach. The Bible however teaches that repentance is a healthy part of a relationship. Apologizing is an important part of our relationship with our children. Apologizing and repenting to God and one another creates a really strong relationship with each other.

Let’s look at some Bible passages:

Psalm 38:18

I confess my iniquity;  
I am sorry for my sin.

James 5:16

Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

Luke 17:3

Pay attention to yourselves! If your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents, forgive him.

Ephesians 4:26

Be angry and do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger,

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

For our children (and us), apologizing can lead to growth and a healthy relationship with others and with God.
