“Fall Concerts at South”

Lutheran High School South invites all to enjoy back-to-back concerts on Sunday and Monday, October 1 and 2. On Sunday evening at 7 pm the high school choirs will present their fall concert in the Kuhlmann Center at the school on Tesson Ferry Road. Four choirs, including the Lancer Singers, will perform. A free will offering will be received, and a cookie reception will follow the concert. On Monday, October 2, over 100 elementary

students from across the region will gather for the Lutheran Youth Choral Festival at LHSS. After a day rehearsing with Dr. Charles Brown from Concordia Chicago, the group will present their concert at 7:00 pm at LHSS. Included on the program are the LHSS Lancer Singers (including Kritika Basnet, Aleina Harper, Nisa Muhammed and Alisse Myers) and Junior Singers (including Sammi Wientge). What’s going on in the Gym?

At the end of July 2017 Salem Lutheran School was blessed to receive a generous donation from a former Salem Member, Mr. Edwin P. Christmann. In his will Mr. Christmann wanted the funds to be used to install air conditioning for the Luepke Auditorium (our gym) or if that was completed, to have the funds used for capital improvements at the school. Mr. Christmann moved to Florida and during the time that he was away, we added air conditioning to the gym.

In speaking with his lawyers at the time prior to his passing and knowing the wording on his will, we wanted to have the gift make a significant impact on an area of the school used by the most people. With his original idea to add air conditioning to the gym, we recognized that although the gym already had air conditioning, it was in need of upgrades.

So, beginning in February 2017, Salem’s Athletic Committee began to research and get bids to use some of the funds that would be coming from the Christmann gift to upgrade the Luepke Auditorium. These plans included securing bids for painting the gym (ceiling to floor), replacing the windows with glass block and adding ventilation fans, moving and replacing the backboards, replacing the bleachers, installing a new multipurpose floor, upgrading the sound system, and replacing and adding padding to the walls.

Some parts of the project have been completed, some are in progress and we hope to have them all completed by the start of our basketball season in November.

The most expensive of these items is the Taraflex Multi-purpose Sports Floor which will provide a safer and more attractive surface for both our physical education classes and athletic events. Since it is a multipurpose gym, we needed to replace the chairs that will be used for events with chairs that will be safer to use on the new floor. Funds from our yearly magazine sale and our Salem PATS (Parents and Teachers for Salem) were used to buy 250 new chairs for the Luepke Auditorium.

In the hallway outside of the gym we will be creating a memorial donation wall. This will recognize the significant donation from the Christmann Family as well as other donors for the ongoing programs and activities in our school.

We are thankful to God for Mr. Christmann on his tremendous generosity, forward thinking, and dedication to preserve future ministry here at Salem Lutheran Church and School. If you have an interest in donating towards our programs at Salem please contact us in the school office.
