Gym Renovation Update

We're signed on with an asbestos abatement company and scheduled for the removal of the gym tiles beginning Monday, October 23. The company again has assured us that in our current situation and during any removal, there are no issues or dangers with regards to the asbestos. A separate company has been hired for air monitoring before, during and after the removal.

In the meantime, the new flooring will be ready for install beginning immediately after the tile removal and the bleachers will be ready to install soon after.

We've ordered some replacement parts for the restrooms near the gym, some new replacement parts for the scoreboard and new padded "Wildcat" chairs for the teams should be arriving by the end of the month.

Again, while we are anxious to have everything completed and a fantastic new floor installed, we need to continue to be patient.
