## Gym Renovation Update

Here is your gym renovation update for Thursday, October 26:

Things are really moving along on the renovation to the gym. Mrs. Carney had students in our PE classes "sign" the tiles in a farewell to our gym floor(s). The abatement company is working in the gym nightly to safely remove all the tiles (both layers). They indicated that they will be done next Friday, November 3. After they finish we have the flooring company scheduled to install our new Teraflex Flooring. Soon after the floor is complete, we'll be installing 70 feet of new plastic bleachers. The bleachers will be on the South side only of the gym and when extended will have 5 rows of seating. Our new Salem Wildcat padded team folding chairs have arrived. We have 30 padded chairs for our athletes and visiting teams to sit on. They will be kept in the closet and used only for games. We are working on the schedules for our basketball teams around the construction. We also are working on the new "Wall of Fame" donor wall to compile a list of donors for the gym renovation and updates. There will be many ways for families and individuals to contribute. Donations of any amount are welcome. To be included on the Donor Wall donations of \$100 or more may be made. More information will be shared soon.
